There is a good possibility that the City will revise the Low Density Zone amendments, given the feedback from the [EFCL Workshops](#), individual Leagues and others. We will find out late February 25th when the March 18th Public Hearing agenda is put on the [Council meetings web-page](#).

EFCL is organizing a March 6th, 7 pm meeting at Windsor Park Hall, 11840 - 87 Ave. Leagues will have an opportunity to review the changes, develop joint recommendations, and prepare a coordinated response for the Public Hearing if that is deemed to be beneficial. Hopefully the City will have made some positive changes to the amendments, and Leagues will be able to praise to the City for responding to the concerns of Leagues.
