Planning Matters

How do you want to be consulted on cell tower locations – paper survey or a meeting?

The EFCL is working with the city to develop a better consultation process regarding the location of telecommunications towers. If a cell tower proponent wishes to build a tower in a residential area, the proponent is required to hold a community meeting and document the comments and questions. Several Community Leagues have expressed dissatisfaction with the meetings. Thus, EFCL is exploring other options to replace or supplement the meetings.
